Methodology and principal findings



Research Objectives And Methodology



Why?

The research objective was to obtain teachers' views on Additional Assessment Components (AACs)* currently in their subject area(s) and on the Minister's proposal that there will be AACs in each subject of a minimum of 40%.

How Many?

2,758 ASTI members out of a sample of circa 14,000 took part in the survey. This represents a response rate of 20% - one of the strongest responses to an ASTI survey in recent years.

Who?

The participants includes 2,720 classroom teachers, 10 principals and 28 deputy principals who also had subject responsibility.

When?

Fieldwork was conducted in November 2024.

How?

The survey instrument was an online questionnaire sent by RED C to circa 14,000 ASTI members on email database.


*The term Additional Assessment Component (AAC) is the umbrella term for any form of assessment in addition to the written examination.



Employment Status










Q. What type of school do you teach in? (Base: All Respondents)





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
Subjects Taught



Respondents were most likely to be teaching English or mathematics, though biology, history, business, Gaeilge and geography are taught by around one in ten.


Teacher satisfaction with **AAC** allocation of 40% in revised specifications



Satisfaction With Allocation of 40% In Revised Specification



Three in four (or more) are dissatisfied with the allocation of a minimum of 40% for the AAC in the revised specification for those subjects which currently have none.



Majority propose 20% or below across each of the subjects with many choosing 0%, while mathematics, accounting and English have the lowest proposed average % allocations.













The majority of teachers of subjects which currently have an AAC would prefer to retain the current % mark.






High agreement with negative impacts and high disagreement with positive impacts of a minimum of 40% AAC being applied.




Concerns About Authenticating Students' Work



Though there are some exceptions in certain subjects below (particularly art), in the main, many teachers have concerns about authenticating students' work submitted as part of the AAC.






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


Currently, project work in 10 Leaving Certificate subjects is submitted to the State Examinations Commission (SEC) in the format of an SEC-standardised digital booklet:


Q. Which devices did students use to complete their digital booklet for SUBJECT? Please select all that apply.

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
Q. Which devices did students use to complete their digital booklet for SUBJECT? Please select all that apply.




Submission of Digital Booklets



Despite high levels of submissions made by subject teachers, only 2% have received training on how to do it. Eight in ten experience technical difficulties when submitting. Only three in ten believe the IT system can do the processing securely.


Job satisfaction
